August Meeting



Football Defensive Line Coach Clint Hurtt

Our scheduled speaker for the August meeting is Defensive Line Coach and Head Recruiter Clint Hurtt. If you will recall, Coach Hurtt was recognized after last season as the top football recruiter in the nation for his outstanding efforts in bring high caliber athletes to the UofL football program. A tireless recruiter and an aggressive defensive mind, Clint Hurtt begins his second season as defensive line coach and recruiting coordinator at the University of Louisville. In two seasons in Louisville, Hurtt has put together consecutive solid recruiting classes, including his 2010 class, which is shaping up to be one of the best in the history of the school. The Cardinals are ranked in the top 30 of Scout and Rivals rankings. For his efforts this season, Hurtt was recognized by ESPN.com as the National Recruiter of the Year. Tutoring the defensive line in 2010, Hurtt took an inexperienced unit and molded it into a surprisingly consistent unit. Senior defensive end Rodney Gnat led the Cardinals in sacks with nine and senior Malcolm Tatum recorded a career-best 44 stops, which was tops among the defensive line. Hurtt came to Louisville after spending three seasons at Miami (Fla.), his alma mater. Hurtt signed the top class in the Atlantic Coast Conference in 2008 and 2009, while with the Hurricanes. He helped sign the No.1 recruiting class in the country in 2008, according to ESPN.com. The 2009 class was ranked in the top 10 in the country as six of the signees were ranked in the ESPN.com Top 150. Hurtt was a three-year letterman for the Hurricanes as a defensive lineman. He signed with Miami in 1997 and played extensively as a freshman before redshirting in 1998 to recover from an injury. Hurtt returned to the lineup and saw extensive action in 1999 and 2000 before an injury prior to the 2001 season ended his playing career. After the injury, Hurtt joined the Hurricanes staff as a volunteer assistant on the strength and conditioning staff. In 2003, he was named a graduate assistant and worked with the defensive line for two seasons.

A native of Rochester, N.Y., Hurtt had an outstanding prep career at Milford (Conn.) Academy. He graduated from the University of Miami in 2001 with a degree in criminology and liberal arts. His father, Clinton, played for the New York Jets and Baltimore Colts. Hurtt is married to Tanisha, and the couple has two children, Taylor and Clayton.

President's Message...

It's time for another year of UofL sports. The successes enjoyed by the teams in 2010-11 resulted in banner recruiting efforts that have raised expectations even higher 2011-12. And don't forget the addition of new coaches who are ready to bring their brand of excitement to their teams. Just like the sports teams, the Central Cardinal Club had a banner year in 2010-11 by raising and donating \$16,000 to athletic teams at the UofL. And that means the bar has been set higher for 2011-12. The annual Holiday Boutique and Style Show has grown to the point it will be moved to the PNC Room at Papa John's Cardinal Stadium. More floor space will hopefully mean more patrons attending and shopping with the vendors who will be there.

Our meeting on August 9th will also be at the PNC Room. This will give everyone an opportunity to see where the Holiday Boutique and Fashion Show will be held. That also means departing from the tradition of the CCC providing free pizza and soft drinks for the August meeting. We are obligated to use Centerplate Catering for our meal that night. The menu will consist of grilled burgers, hot dogs and brats with baked potato salad, potato chips with ranch dip, popcorn, softdrinks, tea and coffee. The cost will be \$13.00 per person. Please consider that the normal rental fee for the PNC Room has been waived for both the August meeting and the Holiday Boutique and Style Show.

Also, we are still in the process of negotiating the project increase in the cost per meal at the University Club. In the past the per person cost was \$12.00. That amount covered not only the buffet dinner but also included the tip and cost of the meeting person room. If you will recall, at the May meeting it was announced the cost would increase to \$13.00 per. After that meeting we were informed twice of additional increase up to \$15.00 per person. Steve and Janie McNeil have been working with the staff at the University Club in an attempt to hold the cost at \$13.00. Several options have been presented by Steve and Janie and they continue to work to reach an agreement with the University Club for the meals with our meetings.

I will tell you that the Board of Directors have explored many options for moving the location of our regular meetings, but in each instance we were looking at a cost of over \$15.00 per person. In every case that was due to the rental fee that would be assessed. We even looked at going to a pitch –in dinner our meetings, but all of the facilities we visited would not permit that. You have our pledge that we will do everything in our power to keep the meetings on campus and the costs at a reasonable rate. At the same time we understand that today's economy is having an impact on the hospitality and food and beverage industry.

In closing I want to thank Don Hopwood for his outstanding leadership last season. I know with many personal issues facing Don and his wife Jackie that it was challenging at times, but Don did a great job and I hope I am able to fill his shoes.

The CCC Board looks forward to a having a great time this coming year as we celebrate successes of the UofL athletic teams with fellowship and companionship at our meetings. Until August 9 everyone stay cool and safe.
